Over past week (from 19th March to 26th March): The cost of the household food basket *increased* by R7,91 (0,2%) from R3 320,35 on the 19th of March 2020 to R3 328,26 on the 26th of March 2020.

Over past 4 weeks (from 2nd March to 26th March): The cost of the household food basket *increased* by R107,26 (3,3%) from R3 221,00 on the 2nd of March 2020 to R3 328,26 on the 26th of March 2020.

The household food basket includes the foods and the volumes of these foods which women living in a household with seven members (the average low-income household size in Pietermaritzburg) tell us they typically try and secure each month. Food prices are sourced from supermarkets (5) and butcheries (4) that target the low-income market in Pietermaritzburg and which women identified as those they shop at. The supermarkets we track are not those which target the middle-class viz. Checkers/Shoprite, Spar, Pick n Pay or Woolworths; and therefore these supermarkets tend to fall outside of the public gaze. The usual dates for data collection fall between the 1st and 4th day of each month, however with the Covid-19 pandemic, PMBEJD will track food prices more frequently.

Along with washing hands and physical distancing, it is important that South Africans are also advised to eat proper nutritious food. The first line of defence against disease is our bodies. Eating proper nutritious food is critical to support health and build a strong immune system to resist disease.

Over past week (from 19th March to 26th March): The cost of the household domestic and personal hygiene products basket *decreased* by R0,25 (-0%) from R673,39 on the 19th of March 2020 to R673,14 on the 26th of March 2020.

Over past 4 weeks (from 2nd March to 26th March): The cost of the household domestic and personal hygiene products basket *increased* by R13,05 (2,0%) from R660,09 on the 2nd of March 2020 to R673,14 on the 25th of March 2020.

Domestic and personal hygiene products are critical expenses for safe hygiene and overall health and well being. The money needed to secure domestic and personal hygiene products are sourced from within the food budget. These products compete with the food budget.
